

Citizenship (N600)

The process through which an individual born outside of the United States applies for a certificate of citizenship to demonstrate that they are U.S. citizens. Foreign born individuals may be U.S. citizens at the time of birth or by operation of law depending on the immigration status of their parents and sometimes grandparents.

Please know that you are required to notify U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services of any change of address. Citizenship law is very complicated; individuals should consult with an immigration attorney to determine eligibility.
